We are pleased to report that your partnership in providing the 2015 Summer Day Camp made transformation a reality for neighborhood children, your local church, and college students! As we work together to build relationships with families in your immediate neighborhood through the After-School Program, we build upon the great results of the summer at your site:

- Number of children you built a relationship with through PT: 131
- Percentage of children qualified for free and reduced lunch: 80%
- Provided 5630 Meals and Snacks for Children
- Percentage of Regular Attendees Maintaining or Improving Elementary Reading
  Level: 89%
- Percentage who improved one or more levels: 75%
- Number of books read by elementary students: 1460
- Average number of books read per elementary student: 11
- Number of reading volunteers who built relationships through PT: 109
- Hours spent reading and connecting with children by volunteers: 819
- Number of young adult AmeriCorps Members you helped discern their God-given purpose: 13
