This Sunday

Names are powerful things. You might have heard something similar to this in your life. If not, you have heard it now. Names are powerful things. Many names that we hear every day have emotions and meanings attached to them from something in our past. When we hear the name Lincoln, we think of one of the great Presidents in our history. When we hear the name Moses, we think of the Exodus story, and how Moses led the way for the Jews in the desert, away from captivity. Names are important and powerful things whether we realize this or not.

What about the names of God? When we think of some of the names of God found in the Bible, what do we think of and what does that tell us? In this new sermon series, we will be exploring a few of the names for God and their meanings. The hope is that by the end of the series, we will come to know God a little better and to know what God means to us, personally.

Last week, we looked at the story of Moses and the burning bush, where God tells Moses that he is called "I AM." This tells us of a God that is always present, always here with us.
