

4. How it is celebrated

The Library of Congress, the National Archives and Records Administration, the National Humanities Foundation, the National Art Gallery, the National Parks Service, the Smithsonian Institution and the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum come together to pay tribute to the Spanish-American generations that have positively influenced and enriched our nation and society.


