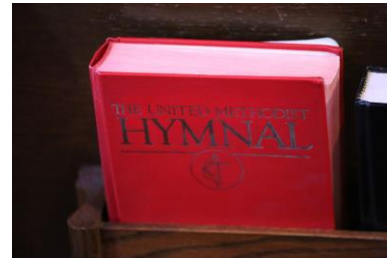
What – All Church Workday

This anthem is a hymn of praise, a prayer for God's presence in our lives, and an affirmation of praising God "anyhow!" It's a promise of praise encompassing the good times and lows of our lives. Are we living a testimony having an expectation of Christ-filled joy and Christ-filled peace in our lives? Are we testimonies of having angry, fearful, faithless spirits?

Or do we boldly proclaim, "As long as I have breath, I praise, anyhow!"

"As long as I have breath, I serve, anyhow!"

There are three scriptures which come to mind relating to the text. One is Psalm 150:6, which enjoins everything that has breath to praise the Lord, taking in all of creation. Another scripture is that which claims the promise found in John 14:27: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." The third scripture is Psalm 146:2, I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being. And we may fairly conclude that the Psalmist stretches his thoughts beyond the limits of time, and contemplates that scene of eternal praise!
