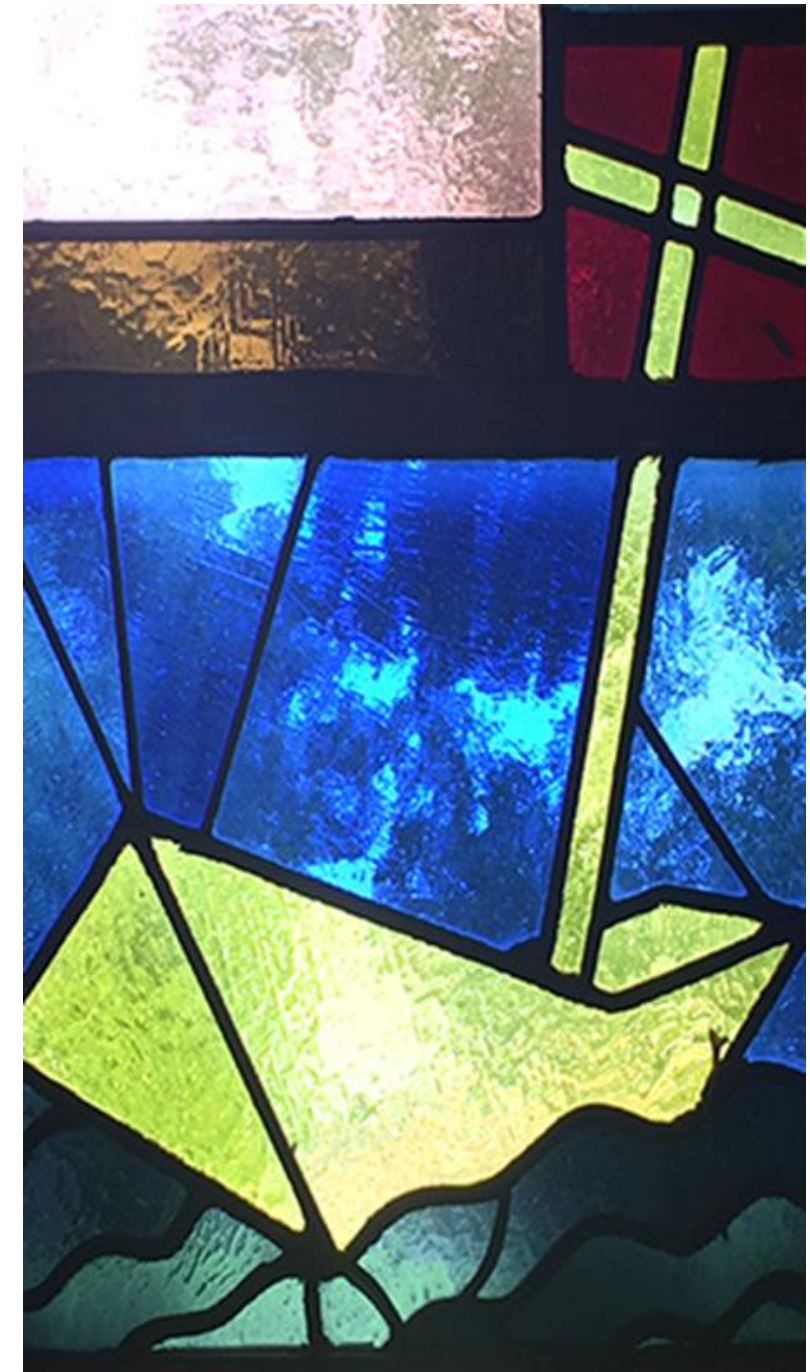

Meeting Rev. JD Allen

Here is this week's excerpt from Rev. JD Allen's biography.



During my time at FUMC The Colony I helped lead the charge to start a community garden and a citizenship class to serve our neighbors. We connected the citizenship class members to UMCOR's Justice for Our Neighbors when they needed legal consultation regarding their immigration status and application for citizenship. I also shared preaching responsibilities in our modern worship service and was in the process of building a coalition to launch a low-income health clinic in The Colony when I left to enter ministry.

In the years to come, I spent two years as a student local pastor at Elm Ridge United Methodist Church and one year as the Associate Pastor at First United Methodist Church Carrollton before serving as the pastor of First United Methodist Church of Boyd for the last five years. At FUMC Carrollton, I began the process of helping the church formulate a pathway of discipleship and connecting the theologically disparate churches of Carrollton together in service before our move to Boyd prevented me from completing those tasks. We did, however, establish a Black Friday mission in which we provided some meals and snacks for those working in some local stores during the seasonal shipping rush following Thanksgiving.
