My faith shift occurred as I wrestled with the prophetic call to justice and love of neighbor in the Old Testament and the teachings of Jesus. It led me to seek to hunger first for justice and righteousness. As a result, I spent time on the board of and serving with the Dallas Area Progressive Christian Alliance and participating in the work of Jobs with Justice Dallas and the Workers Defense Project.

Many aspects of United Methodism led me to give organized religion a chance again when my approach had become to hold onto my faith in Jesus the Christ while not participating in an established church. Those included the Wesleyan Quadrilateral, the Social Principles, the inclusion of women in ministry, and the Church's commitment to service in the community.
