As a follow up to Sunday, I pray that we are finding time and utilizing ways to allow God to love us. God's grace is beautiful in that God is seeking us even when we do not know or do not seek God's love ourselves. When we respond to that grace and let God love us, a relationship of mutuality opens up and God's grace fills us in a way that brings us faith, hope, and love.

Faith, hope, and love prepare us for fulfilling relationships with not only God but our neighbors as well. God's grace empowers us to see ourselves as God see us so we can approach God without shame and self-judgment. We are then empowered to see others as God sees them; with compassion, absent of shaming and judgment.

With this in mind, I invite you to accept Sunday's invitation. You are invited to commit to praying the Lord's Prayer individually, and as families, twice a day for 21 days. Why 21 days? Because when we do something for 21 days, it becomes a habit.

This exercise may be a minor addition to an already vibrant life of prayer and searching the scriptures. Or it may be a beginning for us. You could pray the version we recite in worship from The Gospel According to Matthew or the shorter form we read in Luke 11 last Sunday. You can even alternate between the two. Either way, as we recite this prayer twice daily we can reflect on God who loves us, provides for us, forgives us, and equips us to love one another. We can understand that God longs to love us not just individually but in community as well. And as we let God love us, our lives and communities will be renewed with faith, hope, and love.

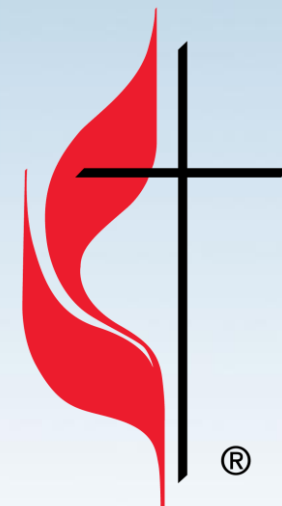
In addition, while the address the emails come from says "no-reply" please know that if you do reply to these emails the replies will come to church office. Thank you.

MOP for Outreach Mission to Central Brazil

Each mission participant will take 2 suitcases, with 50 pounds per suitcase of items needed in the communities we will visit. I've got my dentist ordering toothbrushes, my dermatologist on small sunscreens, and other friends figuring out what they might send... and now I am asking you, in my church family, please look at the list below, and, if so moved, bring any of the listed items to church no later than 8/11, put them in the marked box in the church office, and if necessary, label them "AMAZON OUTREACH".

This is a quick collection, and anything that makes sense for you helps. Sometimes a person has access to items in larger quantities for reasons that wouldn't be obvious. (Have a huge bag of unused emery boards from an ad campaign years ago?... stuff like that!) I ask that you put your thinking caps on and see if you have some kind of 'in' to quantities of any of the following:

Items to donate:

Cloth diapers, new or gently used baby and small children's clothes, pacifiers, sandals and flip flops, baseball hats, sunglasses, soap, sample sized toiletries, antiseptic cream, cortisone cream, vitamins (prenatal, adult and children's w/iron), Tylenol, ibuprofen (we will be dividing up vitamins and analgesics, so the XL size, most cost effective bottles make best sense), individually wrapped non-melting candies
