We began our Lenten journey on Ash Wednesday reflecting on how, while our individual and collective sin has created chaos and brokenness, God's grace calls into the hope of God's future for creation. Through our intentional devotion and discipline during this season, God's grace shapes us as disciples as we recommit to God's love and the Reign of God on earth as it is in heaven.
