This week, we continue our reflections on the February 19 sermon of Bishop Ruben Saenz, Jr., and the United Methodist message of "our message of God's grace and our concern and commitment for personal holiness, evangelism, service in the world, and social justice,"

Let us reflect on Bishop Saenz's third emphasis: strengthening the bonds of our sacred connection with God, with each other, and with our neighbors and collaborating with our sister churches, with our ecumenical partners, and with community associates.

Strengthening our sacred bond with God and each can come with a renewed focus on our means of grace: worship and sacraments, prayer and bible study both individually and together, holy conferencing in which we encourage one another along the way, fasting, serving our neighbors, and working for justice. All of these things are shared with us by God as means by which we can connect with God's grace and be continually transformed by God's love on our way to Christian Perfection in which love guides our lives. This is encapsulated in our General Rule of Discipleship: to witness to Jesus Christ in the world and to follow his teachings through acts of compassion, justice, worship, and devotion under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

Our connectional system has always shown that we can more fully make disciples for the transformation of the world when we join together with other local churches. We are in a time of transition in the UMC and at CHUMC when such partnership may be all the more vital. We will see this partnership as we join together for Maunday Thursday and Good Friday with Christ UMC. Such partnerships can also empower us in our ministries of witness and outreach in our community, in our conference, in the denomination, and around the globe.

We can also extend the reach of our grace and love received from God by partnering with churches of other denominations, other faith groups, and community organizations. There is a great deal of commonality with churches of other denominations, including those churches that recently disaffiliated from the UMC and other faith groups in terms of the call and privilege to love our neighbors and we can do great things. The same is true for teaming up with community partners such as Metrocrest Services as CHUMC has an extensive history of doing.

Bishop Saenz brings a hopeful vision to our conference. May we find hope and strength through community with God, each other, our neighboring churches, and community organizations as we heed the call to love God and love our neighbor in 2023.
