Over these last several months the process of disaffiliation, as many friends and colleagues have departed our conference and denomination, has impacted our faith communities. Gun violence continues as an all too present tragedy in our state and nation. Also, we remain polarized in our state and nation over this issue and other issues of social and economic matters that impact ourselves and our neighbors. We disagree about our neighbors at our borders. We disagree regarding the value of public schools. We disagree regarding how and what students of diverse races, ethnicities, classes, genders, and sexualities should be taught. We disagree regarding various matters concerning abortion and the health of pregnant women. Threats of violence, "joking" and otherwise, toward those who are different from those making the threats grow not only among the general populace, but among our elected officials.

In the face of such pain and despair, we find hopeful developments. Lay people who found themselves without a United Methodist local church have joined together to plant new churches committed to making disciples for the transformation of the world. People of faith continue to bring good news in word and deed to the poor, the captives, the blind, the oppressed, and bear witness to the day of jubilee. They find Jesus in the hungry, the thirsty, the immigrant, those needing clothes, the sick, and the prisoner and offer care for the least of these who bear the image of God. And people bear witness to the love of God to the immediate neighbors to give them hope in these trying days.

So during the annual conference, we will do the administrative business of the church, including planning for the likely merger of the North Texas and Central Texas Conferences which may also include the Northwest Texas Conference. But we will also gather to worship, learn, pray, and proclaim what it means to truly be the church.

Please be in prayer for our annual conference as we prepare to meet next week.
