We have come to the final foundational belief for United Methodists mentioned by Bishop Ruben Saenz, Jr., in his Dallas Morning News OpEd on July 12: the understanding that love of God and neighbor embraces both the "saving of souls" and "seeking God's justice for the world."

Indeed, these two intimately related emphases are encapsulated in our United Methodist mission statement: to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

Our Wesleyan theology walks us through the journey of salvation in relation to God's grace. There is the part of the journey which is prevenient. It is God reaching out to us when we are unaware of our need for God and grace. There is the point in which we receive justifying grace which helps us to see our sin and need for grace as we ask for God's forgiveness and through which we are empowered by grace through faith to begin to embrace God's will and love above our sin and selfishness. There is, finally, the journey of sanctification in which God's grace aids us in our continued maturing in love as we move on toward perfection in love through Christ. This entire journey is disciple making as disciple making goes beyond praying a prayer of forgiveness to learning how to live as disciples throughout our lives. We may recall the Great Commission calls on the church to not only baptize but to teach them to obey all that Jesus taught. This lifelong journey encompasses the "saving of souls" as we work out our own salvation by God's grace.

As we continue on the journey of salvation, the love shared with us becomes the love through which we craft our relationships on a personal and collective level. This includes treating one another and all our neighbors with justice and by seeking to build just systems and reform unjust systems so that they empower and provide for all. This is related to the prophetic tradition which we see continued in Jesus Christ who fulfilled the law and the prophets. Our lives and work in following Christ continue the proclamation of the good news to the poor, the captives, the blind, and oppressed and providing for those who are hungry, thirsty, the immigrant, those in need of clothing, the sick, and the imprisoned. The Social Principles of the United Methodist Church lay out our understanding of the scriptures in relation to justice.
