We played a game that involved loaves of bread being torn into small pieces which had touched many hands so no one would want to eat them. I decided to take my kids to the lake where we could feed the bread to the ducks. I asked where the best spot to go might be, got my kids in the car, and we drove South to Azle where there was a park at Eagle Mountain Lake where we found a pier to walk out on. To our surprise there were no ducks to be found. Why? Because the drought had dried the lake so badly that the nearest water was hundreds of yards from the end of the pier. All we had in front of us was dry ground and overgrown brush.

Life happens sometimes and our souls feel like that lake. Health problems. Lost loved ones. Growing tensions in the public sphere. Failure. Inflation. The ground of our soul is dried and cracked and, seemingly, void of life. It is in these we can count of the depth of God's love to come to the rescue. To fill the reservoir of our soul with the living water that is Jesus Christ which gives us hope beyond our dry, cracked, overgrown inner life. To remind us of the hope we have for new life and new creation.

That lake? Well, the rains came. It was once again filled, and the waters could once again be enjoyed from the pier. May God's love water our dry souls this day.
