Thank you for supporting the United Methodist Connection through your generosity in our observance of Human Relations Day on Communion Sunday. We raised \$87 to support the development of better human relations by involving congregations in community and youth outreach through Community Developers Programs, United Methodist Voluntary Services Programs, and Youth Offender Rehabilitation Programs. I am so grateful that our local church shares each Communion Sunday to support local, denominational, and other causes which further the transformation of the world.

Speaking of making disciples for the transformation of the world (nice segue, eh?), our evangelism team spent some time together in prayerful Bible study this past Tuesday to explore the ways in which scripture calls us to listen as we seek to share God's love with those around us. A special word we encountered was, "ephphatha." The spittle flew around the room as we tried to pronounce this word. I hope we all had our shots! LOL!

This is the word Jesus spoke as he healed the deaf and mute man who was brought to him in Mark 7:32-35. It translates to "Be opened." He graciously ordered the ears of this man to be opened so he could hear. Often in the gospels, especially in Mark, these healing stories are used to illustrate how Jesus enables those who were previously unable to hear while many of the religious in his day refuse to hear Jesus' message even though they were able.

The Evangelism Team responded by discussing what earwax we sometimes have that needs a spiritual Q-Tip to clean out and remove the obstructions that may make it difficult to hear God's leading at times. Maybe we feel too busy or we're too busy speaking to listen. Maybe we lack interest. Maybe we are comfortable in our routines. Maybe it's the result of presumptions and prejudices. Maybe it's anxiety in situations in which we find ourselves.

Whatever it may be, God has a message for us. A calling to hear as we seek to fulfill our mission to make disciples for the transformation of the world. As we worship, study, and pray and as we listen to God, one another, and our community in the coming months, may our ears, eyes, minds, and hearts be opened to what Christ is already doing and calling us to join.


