

Pastor's Message

This past Saturday, we held our annual Advance meeting, where 10-12 of us gathered to finalize much of our planning for 2024 and prepare spiritually for

We began with Lee Willhite sharing a story about a youth camp which got off to a rough start when one of the campers broke their arm in an accident, leaving the pastor serving as a counselor wondering if he had let his supervisory guard down and feeling rather disappointed that he had let that happen. Later in the week, though, a monarch butterfly appeared in the midst of one of their group devotionals grabbing everyone's attention, including the boy now wearing a cast who the butterfly rested on bringing great joy to the boy, the pastor and the rest of the group. The pastor shared how the butterfly, which is historically viewed as a symbol of resurrection, brought transformation in that moment.

We then participated in a team building activity where we took a stack of pictures from CHUMC's history and had to try and arrange them chronologically. The groups did pretty well, However, there was the one black-and-white photo presumed to be from the early days of CHUMC that turned out to be a late eighties youth trip. Nevertheless, the groups had a wonderful time taking a trip down memory lane, seeing faces from the past, and reflecting on the wonderful ministry, service, and fellowship that has taken place among the people of CHUMC over the years.

This year, these two themes come together. CHUMC has been a wonderful place of ministry and disciple making over the years. However, for a number of reasons CHUMC has been in decline for some time and struggled to regain its footing. However, I trust as we continue through our time of prayer and discernment, I am certain we will have our monarch butterfly moment. There will be a resurrection of life at CHUMC. I cannot tell you at this time what that moment will look like but join with us in prayer and let's remain vigilantly aware, so it will be clear when it arrives.
