As we continue discernment with our Evangelism Team, we continue to listen and seek God's direction in discovering where our gifts, passions, and desires intersect with the gifts, passions, and desires of our community. The completion of our North Texas Conference Close to Home Project Is an example of how finding this intersection can provide hope.

You may recall the tornado that hit Jacksboro in March 2022 causing significant damage to homes and other buildings. In the wake of that disaster, area United Methodist leaders and conference leadership joined with community leaders, government officials, and other religious leaders to address the needs in the community. The contributions included a \$1.4 million grant from UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief) and donations from individuals and local churches across the conference, such as our Communion Sunday offering for the project. Less than two years later, the project was completed with eighty-five families having their homes restored and five families receiving new homes.
